Title:	Choral training camp
Objectives:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● To strengthen choral techniques of the choir ● To build team spirit
Deliverables:	Students would take part in the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival
Target:	36 F4 students and 25 F5 students
Selection mechanism:	Members of Senior Mixed Voice Choir
Duration and venue:	3 days at Chong Yau Pak Wan Residence Hall
Evaluation:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students showed great enthusiasm in various activities in the camp, especially in the mini performance. ● From feedbacks made by the students, the camp has become a tradition and a much looked-forward event. ● Bonding among choir members was raised significantly after the camp. ● A first runner-up and a second runner-up were awarded in two different categories of the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival.
Expenditure:	HKD\$45,360 (for accommodation and material for activities)

Title:	Hiring conductors and coaches for orchestras and bands
Objectives:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● To strengthen performing skills of instrumentalists ● To build team spirit
Deliverables:	Students would take part in the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival, Hong Kong Youth Music Interflows, and The 7 th Winter Band Festival
Target:	38 F4 students and 21 F5 students
Selection mechanism:	Audition by conductors / coaches
Duration and venue:	Weekly practice for whole academic year in school
Evaluation:	In the Hong Kong Youth Music Interflows, our String Orchestra was awarded a Silver Award. In the 7 th Winter Band Festival, our Wind Band was awarded a Gold Award. In the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival, our School Orchestra came second in the Senior Class; our Harmonica Orchestra came first and second respectively in the Harmonica Band and Harmonica Ensemble categories. All music teams held their lunch time concerts respectively.
Expenditure:	HKD\$477,686 (for hiring conductors and coaches for orchestras and bands)
